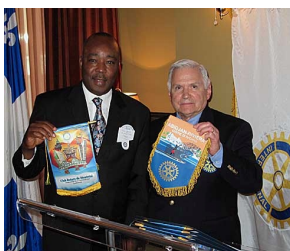
The Awards:
