Hogan**, Royal Heraldry Society of Canada; **Nick Schultze**, member of the Royal Speakeasy Toastmasters Club; **Mark Shalhoub**, CJAD radio sports commentator. It was then time for the judges to leave the room to confer.

After the meal service, **Mark Shalhoub** reported the result of the judges' deliberations: 3<sup>rd</sup> place, **Octavia Dancu**; 2<sup>nd</sup> place, **Aditya Mithani**; 1<sup>st</sup> place, **Adam Richard.** 

Steve Sadler turned the chair back to President Nemo who adjourned the meeting. Regrettably, before a photo showing all five contestants together could be taken, a second photo with fewer contestants was being set up in the far end of the meeting room.
